How To Hear God: A Simple Guide For Normal People boldly declares nothing is more important than learning to discern the authentic voice of God—dividing the book into two parts: hearing his word and his whisper. As a follow-up to his 2021 ECPA Book of the Year nominee, *How To Pray*, Greig continues his honest, straight-forward approach offering readers a guide to hear God with more intentionality and clarity through a connection with Jesus Christ. He weaves together the

evangelical emphasis on hearing God in the Bible, and the charismatic commitment to hearing God in the prophetic, with the contemplative understanding of God's "still, small voice" within.

In addition to being Senior Pastor of Emmaus Rd. in Guildford, England, Greig is best known as founder of the worldwide 24-7 Prayer phenomenon which started over two decades ago, and has now reached more than half the nations on earth. Having addressed God's silence in *God on Mute*, and then *How to Pray* in his previous bestseller, *How to Hear God* takes readers to the other side of the conversation—where “we stop talking about God, at God, or even to God and start talking with Him.”

Greig explores the importance of looking to Jesus first: “It is Jesus who comes to us covertly, disguised in the ordinary, interrupting our conversations on the Emmaus road, just like the couple in Luke 24.” Dissecting this poignant and playful story of Jesus appearing to his followers after his resurrection, Greig explains, “It is his presence that realigns our thinking, and his insights that

bring the Scriptures to life. He enters our homes before we've had a chance to tidy them, sits down at our meal tables, half uninvited, and breaks our hearts by breaking bread."

In *How To Hear to God*, Greig specifically shows how readers will start hearing God more clearly:

- 1) Through the words and life of Jesus Christ
- 2) Through Scripture
- 3) In prayer
- 4) In prophesy
- 5) Through dreams and intuition
- 6) In community, creation, and culture

Greig explains, "Hearing God is not peripheral; it is integral to human history. Neither is it an optional extra for wild-eyed mystics and those who happen to be spiritually inclined. Hearing God is essential to the very purpose for which you and I were made. Without it everything falls apart. But when we learn to love God's Word—to listen and obey—everything aligns."

Pete Greig is a best-selling author, pastor and "bewildered" instigator of the 24-7 Prayer movement which has reached more than half the nations on earth. He is also the Senior Pastor of Emmaus Rd, Guildford, England, an Ambassador for the NGO Tearfund, and teaches at St Mellitus Theological College in London. Pete's publications include *How To Pray, God On Mute, Dirty Glory and Red Moon Rising*. He has also written two courses: The Prayer Course and The Prayer Course II: Unanswered Prayer. He loves art galleries, live music and knocking down walls.
