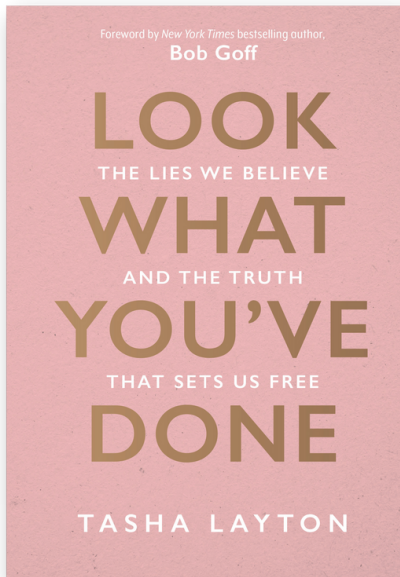


CCM ARTIST TASHA LAYTON RELEASES FIRST BOOK ENTITLED *LOOK WHAT YOU'VE DONE*

From Trailer Park to Touring with Katy Perry...Christian
Vocalist Shares Powerful Life-Lessons



Nashville, TN, January 10, 2023 – “God, where are you?” Throughout her life, Tasha Layton found herself asking this question time and again. In her first book, *Look What You’ve Done: The Lies We Believe & The Truth That Sets Us Free*, Tasha reveals intimate stories from her incredible spiritual and musical journey and the lies that she had to confront along the way. Delivered from suicidal thoughts and catatonic depression, Tasha now walks in the joy and freedom of Jesus and inspires others to recognize God’s presence in both the highs and the lows of their life.

Growing up in rural South Carolina, Tasha never dared dream that she would travel the world singing backup on tour with Katy Perry or be on the mission field in Kenya. Throughout her experiences - no matter how far she traveled - Tasha could not escape the lies that had taken root early in her life. In her search for answers, Tasha explored other religions including mysticism and buddhism. However, no other religion offered the hope that

Tasha found in the presence of Jesus: “As He breathed life back into my aching heart, it became clear to me that Jesus—not any of the other faiths I’d explored—was the one path to God that had truly transformed my life and given me hope to survive.”

TASHA LAYTON is a contemporary Christian musician who finds her identity and purpose in her personal relationship with Jesus. After four years touring as a back-up vocalist for Katy Perry, Layton was first named one of Billboard’s Top 5 female Christian artists of 2020 on the heels of her breakthrough single, “Into The Sea (It’s Gonna Be OK)”. Layton has her Master’s in Divinity from King’s Seminary in Southern California and is a seasoned worship leader. In 2022, she launched her new online show, Boundless, with K-LOVE OnDemand. Publishing in 2023, *Look What You’ve Done: The Lies We Believe & The Truth That Sets Us Free* is her first book. A Dove Award-nominated artist, Tasha Layton tours with artists such as Danny Gokey, Jordan Feliz, and TobyMac.

Suggested Interview Questions for Tasha

- ▶ In your book you share some childhood experiences that shaped your sense of worth in adulthood. As you began your healing journey, were you surprised by the impact those experiences had on your life once you became aware of them?
- ▶ One of the stories you shared was about a painful church experience that derailed your faith. Can you tell us a bit about how you found your way back to the Christian faith after being hurt by the church?
- ▶ You describe a bit about your struggle with depression and suicide. In these vulnerable moments, how did you perceive God in your life?
- ▶ A part of your search for answers included exploring other religions. What did you discover about Christianity that you didn't find in other religions?
- ▶ Throughout your life, you have taken many risks. What risk would you say was the biggest?
- ▶ At the end of each chapter, you give readers a relevant Scripture for that season of your life. What is something God has revealed to you lately about His Word?
- ▶ What does the phrase "salt leaving the saltshaker" mean to you? Can you tell us a bit about how to best represent Christ in untraditional spaces?
- ▶ In the context of God's timing, you say "His no today may just lead you to a much more beautiful yes." How do you manage the 'no' of the present with that in mind?
- ▶ Tell us a bit about the role hope has played in your story. What is your relationship between hope and disappointment?
- ▶ The question of "God where were you when...?" plays a central part in your story. How have you come to reconcile this question in your personal faith?
- ▶ What are some of the hallmarks of God's voice in your life?
- ▶ If you could summarize in one sentence all that God has done in your life, what would it be?
