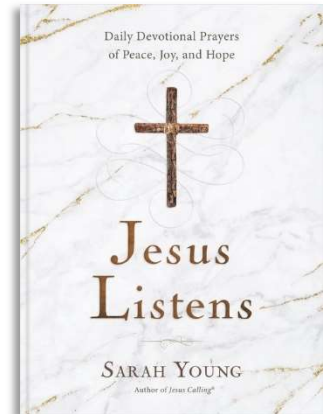

With more than a passing physical resemblance to her sister, Reba McEntire, Susie also shares her big sister’s musical giftings. Susie’s talents have focused on the country gospel side of American Roots music. She has been named “Artist of the Year” several times in the genre of Positive Country Music and has scored four #1 singles on Positive Country radio.

Today Susie feels more energetic and positive about her music than ever before – even as new ventures open up in other arenas. She just completed season two as host of “Jesus Calling: Stories of Faith” (Circle TV), and she also co-hosts television’s “Cowboy Church” (RFDTV, Cowboy channel).

This fall, Susie is also a spokesperson for the latest book in the Jesus Calling family of titles. She is available for interviews to introduce ***Jesus Listens: Daily Devotional Prayers of Peace, Joy, and Hope*** (October 5, 2021), which is authored by Sarah Young.



“*Jesus Calling* made an impact on my life long before I began hosting the Jesus Calling TV show. I love that book because Sarah Young’s writing points readers to Jesus and His love,” Susie explains. “It’s a special honor to introduce ***Jesus Listens*** to readers, because I want folks to experience the joy of sharing their concerns and joys with Jesus every day of the year.”

Susie often reflects on her early Christian experiences during concerts, combining her music with inspiring, personal stories. “The person who influenced me the most for Christ was my Grandma Smith who babysat me while my siblings went to school,” Susie remembers fondly. “Through her influence I recognized what Christianity was really all about: more than just going to church, Christian faith was about Jesus living His life through me.”

Susie’s music catalog reflects her life story in all its heartbreak, healing, and hope. “Looking back, I clearly see God’s hand of guidance through all of the difficult moments in my life. By sharing my story, I hope to help someone else find their way through whatever they may be facing. I can think of no greater purpose for my music than that. It is my joy to point folks to Jesus Christ in my own down to earth, country style.”

Susie and her husband Mark Eaton bring music, stories, joy, hope and authenticity to audiences across North America.

## INTERVIEW QUESTIONS:

- You and your siblings grew up singing together in Oklahoma as the Singing McEntires. What was it like to perform as a family? Did you continue to perform once Reba began her solo career?
- How was faith part of your childhood? Is that a part of life you still share with your family?
- How did you become a Country Gospel artist? Do you consider your music a ministry?
- How did you become the host of the “Jesus Calling: Stories of Faith” TV program? Were you familiar with *Jesus Calling* before the show? Do other family members read *Jesus Calling*?
- How is *Jesus Listens* different from other Jesus Calling titles? (first-person prayers, rooted in scripture)
- Who first taught you to pray? (How Grandma Smith taught the McEntire sisters to pray as children)
- How do you pray when you don’t feel like praying? (prayers of gratitude)
- If someone is new to prayer, what is a simple way to slip prayer into the day? (short prayers for anytime, from Sarah Young)
- Should readers begin *Jesus Listens* now or wait until January 1? (*Jesus Listens* isn’t dated, so readers can begin any time. These daily prayers may help them shape their own prayers.)
- Can you share a story about God answering a prayer in your life?
- What did prayer look like when you were raising your three (now grown) children?
- What does prayer look like today for you and your husband Mark?
