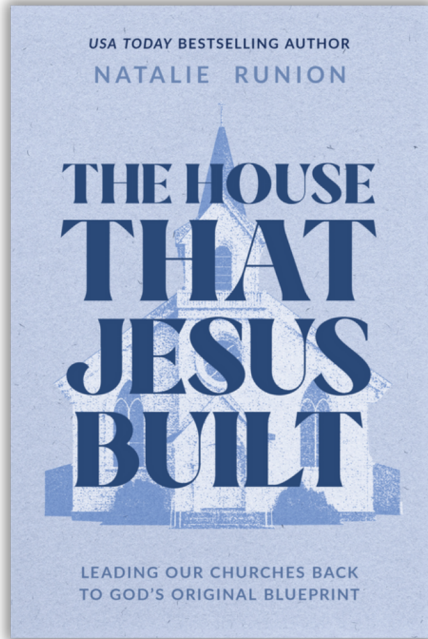




THE HOUSE THAT JESUS BUILT

Excerpt from *The House That Jesus Built*

The last ten years have brought the largest deconstruction movement the Evangelical Church has seen in our lifetime. Movements and marketing campaigns coaxing people back into pews are no longer working. The man-made strategies and plans to get believers and non-believers through their doors aren't as effective as in decades past.

If hot coffee, donuts, and famous bands headlining Sunday morning services worked, our churches would be filled and overflowing. Nothing you and I have to offer in the flesh can rebuild the Church from this unprecedented destruction, and we're standing in the aftermath of our own doing. We've been off mission, and now God is demanding His House be brought back to order.

Cancel the back-to-church campaigns and slick programs. The foundation of the Church has been compromised. Our only option is to acknowledge the damage and invite Jesus back into His home to start the rebuilding process. This is a season of tearing down broken infrastructures and uprooting from barren soil.

We read in Ecclesiastes chapter 3 that there is a season for everything and in verse three, "a time to tear down and a time to build up." Deconstruction isn't the end of the Church; it is an opportunity and invitation to rebuild a Church with Jesus alongside our brothers and sisters in the faith desperate to see His Kingdom come on earth as it is in Heaven.

It's time for the Kingdom builders to come out of hiding and begin surveying our current condition, with our blueprint in hand: the Word of God. Are you ready to partner with Jesus in His Church in a rapidly changing world carrying a never-changing Gospel?

Suggested Interview Questions

- ▶ Your first book, *Raised to Stay*, has powerfully resonated with readers. How has the book's impact influenced your ministry?
- ▶ Your new book is *The House that Jesus Built: Leading Our Churches Back to God's Original Blueprint*. How does this new title build on the message of your previous book, *Raised to Stay*?
- ▶ Do you see your new book as a response to the recent "great resignation" of church leaders?
- ▶ Rebuilding church culture from the inside sounds like an overwhelming undertaking. If church members and/or leaders realize they have strayed from God's blueprint, where do they begin?
- ▶ You write that building (or rebuilding) healthy, holy and safe churches will follow a similar process to building a house. How so?
- ▶ The concepts in *The House that Jesus Built* are rooted in your study of the book of Acts. What concept was most profound as you studied the apostles and the early church?
- ▶ How can someone faithfully serve in their local church if the church leader(s) don't have the healthiest leadership qualities or motives?
- ▶ You write that "many churches have spiritual orphans leading spiritual orphans. These leaders compromise their integrity and convictions to fit in, hurting and excluding others in the process." What does this look like in a local church?
- ▶ What do you mean by the term "rubblization," and how does it apply to the rebuilding of churches?
- ▶ You coined the phrase "The Wheel of Favor" to describe a particular style of church leadership. Tell us more.
- ▶ Worship is an integral part of a healthy church culture. What did that look like in the early Church, and what does it look like in churches today?
- ▶ What kinds of practical proofs reveal that a congregation is a healthy, purpose-filled church?
- ▶ When you describe churches that stay on mission, you highlight the three areas of assignment within the Great Commission. Tell us more about ministry within our own "Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria"?
- ▶ What encouragement can you offer to the church leaders and church members who have stayed as others – friends, family, coworkers – have left the church?
